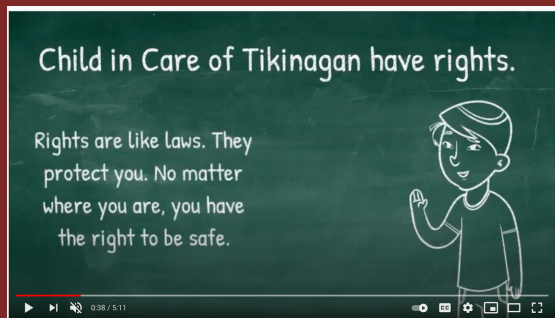

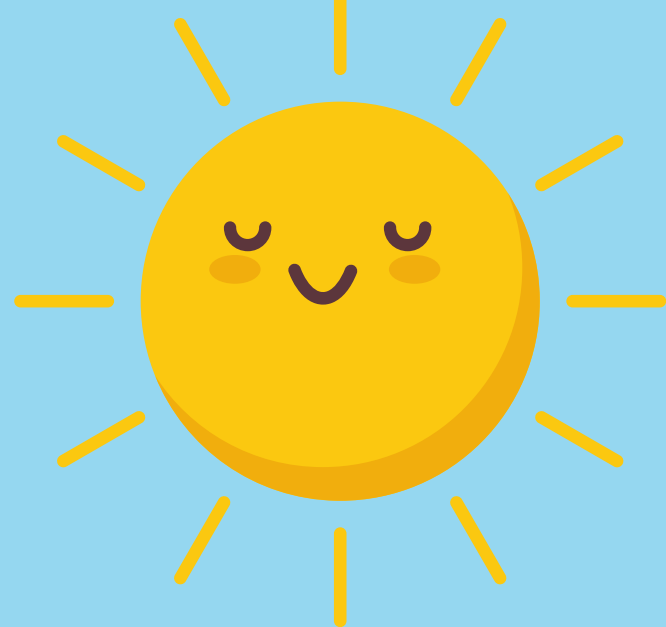

That's what Tikinagan wants for you: they want you to feel like a big, strong, and healthy tree! As Spring comes this year, you will still keep your branches of support like your Foster Family and Dilico Worker. You will have a Tikinagan worker along with your Dilico Worker. You'll meet with them once a month.

For trees to grow healthy, they need the help of water and sun. Tikinagan wants to strengthen your roots to ensure you're connected with your family and First Nation. Tikinagan will work with Dilico to ensure all aspects of your well-being and needs are being met. All this help is like the nutrients a tree needs to grow. The further and deeper tree roots grow, the stronger they are!

And like a tree that keeps growing, everyone who cares about you will work together to make sure you grow up healthy and strong.
